The Deutschlandstipendium Scholarship at the University of Bonn

The Deutschlandstipendium scholarship provides long-term support to particularly talented and responsible students. At the same time, the German government is using this program to help establish a scholarship culture.

Each scholarship recipient gets €300 a month (€3,600 a year). The Deutschlandstipendium scholarship is awarded irrespective of income or BAföG criteria. However, recipients are not permitted to accept a scholarship from another funding institution at the same time.

The Deutschlandstipendium scholarship is aimed at:

- Students on a degree program (bachelor's degree, master's degree, state examination, Church degree, magister's degree) at the University of Bonn
- > All high-school graduates and prospective students looking to begin a degree at the University of Bonn in the near future

Requirements for receiving a Deutschlandstipendium scholarship:

- > Very good school or study achievements
- Social engagement outside school or university

Information on applications for current and prospective students

Applications for the upcoming winter semester can be submitted in **spring.** The funding period for the Deutschlandstipendium scholarship begins on **October 1**.

Details of the exact application period for the Deutschlandstipendium scholarship will be published on **www.uni-bonn.de/deutschlandstipendium** in January. Your will need to apply **online** via an application server. This requires a one-time registration. You will then be able to complete the application form and upload all of the necessary documents to the application server.

Postal applications will not be accepted.

High-school graduates whose Abitur certificate is not yet available at the end of the application phase have the option of submitting only this certificate at a later date. All other documents must be submitted by the deadline.
