This is a temporary joint position for a period of 5 years and is based on a cooperation of HCM and MPIM according to the Jülicher Modell.

We are looking for a young researcher holding a doctoral degree who is starting to develop their own research agenda. Suitable candidates should have already demonstrated scientific

independence with relevant publications. Candidates should have some international research experience.

Research focus

We seek candidates who fit into the broad spectrum of the Cluster of Excellence and the Max Planck Institute for Mathematics in Bonn and complement the existing expertise.

Deadline for applications: 28th September 2024. The deadline also applies to letters of recommendation. The expected starting date is not later than 1 October 2025.
