Dr. Hannah Illing invites applications for one research assistant position (m/w/d) at the **Institute for Applied Microeconomics** at the University of Bonn. The applicant should currently be enrolled in a Master's of Economics (or equivalent) program.

Dr. Illing conducts empirical research in the field of applied microeconomics, in particular labor economics. Your responsibilities will include working on research projects, with a central focus on data work, conducting literature reviews, and occasional administrative support. Experience with statistical programming language (at least one of Stata, R, Python) is required. The successful candidate will be fluent in English or German.

Starting date is September 1, 2024. The appointment will be for a period of 12 months. The position is for 8 hours/week and will be paid EUR 14,36 in September and EUR 15,15/hour from October on.
