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1. New regulation for parental allowance for births from April 1, 2024

For all births from April 1st of this year, a new income threshold comes into effect, from which the entitlement to parental allowance no longer applies. The options for receiving parental allowance at the same time are also being revised. All important information is summarized <u>here</u>.



2. The Diversity Days 2024

On 22 and 23 May 2024, the Vice-Rectorate for Equal Opportunities and Diversity, together with the unit of the same name, is organizing the Diversity Days for the third time at the University of Bonn. The first day will have the motto "Language connects" and is, among other things, dedicated to inclusive language. On day two, which focuses on the topic of "Women Empowering STEM", successful female scientists will report on their professional careers. Family-Sunday at Museum König
